Senior Class

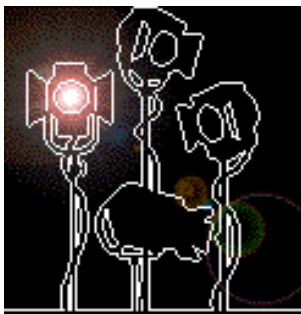
