

### **Pumpkin and Ricotta pastries**

#### **Ingredients:**

2 Tbsp olive oil  
1 onion chopped  
4 sage leaves chopped  
Pinch of salt  
200 g carrots- grated  
250 g pumpkin-grated  
50 ml chicken stock  
1 egg  
150 g ricotta 40 g tasty cheese  
Pepper  
16 sheets filo pastry  
100 g melted butter

#### **Method:**

Heat oven to 180  
Heat olive oil in a large saucepan, add  
onion, sage and salt.  
Cook for 10 minutes, stirring.  
Add carrots and pumpkin, stir until  
vegetables start to soften.  
Add stock and cook 5 minutes then  
allow to cool a bit.  
Add egg, cheeses and pepper. Mix well  
Take a sheet of filo and fold down the  
middle, brush with butter and fold  
down the middle again to make a long  
strip. Brush with butter again.  
Place 1 Tbsp of filling in the bottom  
corner of your pastry and fold the  
corner to make a triangle.  
Fold again and continue to make a  
triangle parcel.  
Place on a baking sheet and brush with  
butter.  
When all the pastries have been made,  
bake for 25 to 30 minutes until golden.
