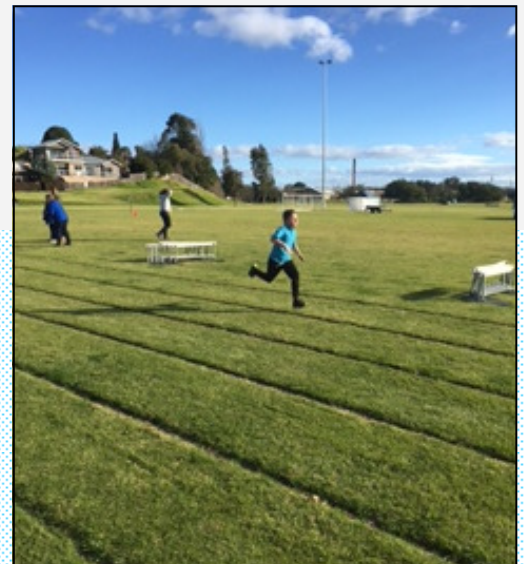
## CLUSTER ATHLETICS DAY

A huge thankyou to Liane and Mick for assisting John and supporting the children.

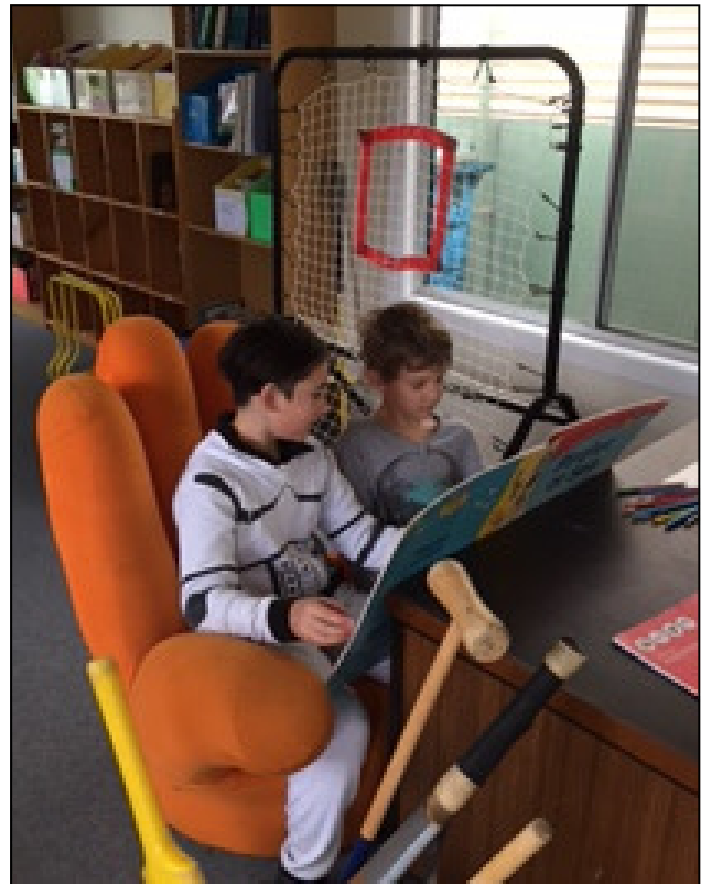
