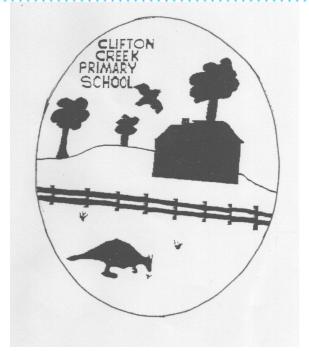

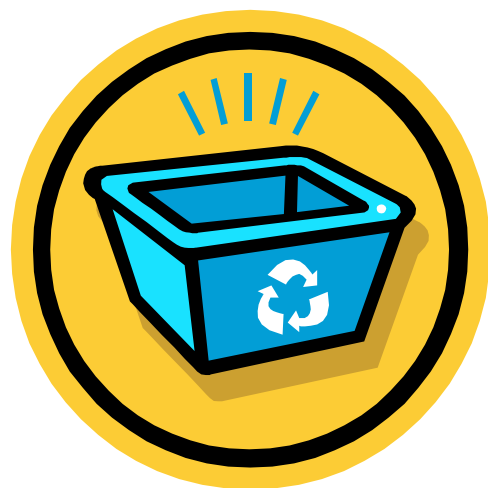
Easter mates
