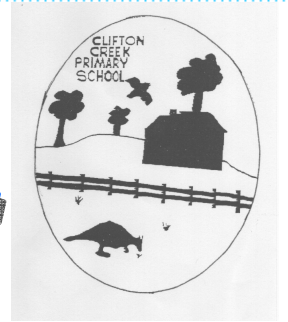

They were all tired when we went to bed and slept well too.

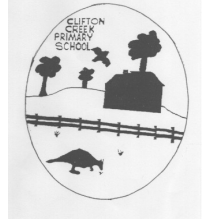
It was just a great experience in so many ways, well done kids!
