**Materials Recovery Facility** at Tambo Waste, 76 MacMillan St, Lucknow. Open to the public Monday to Friday from 8am to 2pm. (There is less truck traffic in afternoon and this is a better time to visit if you can)

## **CLIFTON CREEK COMMUNITY RECYCLING**

is offered by our primary school to local residents in the absence of kerbside recycling services from the start of February to the end of November each year.

We have facilities for paper/cardboard collection as well as general daily household recycling.

Please place your CLEAN recycled articles in the labelled 240 litre bins located near the front gate of the school.

Volunteers from Clifton Creek Primary School drive our Community Recycling Trailer into the Bairnsdale Transfer Station or to the Materials Recovery Facility at Tambo Waste.

If you would like to be part of our driving roster, please give us a yell.

### **RECYCLE RIGHT**

Some basic things to remember when sorting your items for recycling:

- ◆ Keep it loose ~ never enclose items in plastic bags.
- ◆ Keep it clean-ish~ scrape off solid foods and give it a quick rinse.
- ◆ If in doubt, leave it out.



### Items that CAN be left at Clifton Creek Community Recycling bin.

- Clean paper of all sorts and cardboard packaging (not waxed)
- Milk and Juice cartons with caps removed
- Glass bottle and jars
- Steel cans, aluminium cans and clean alfoil
- Rigid plastic containers numbered 1-7

### Items that CANNOT be left at Clifton Creek Community Recycling bin.

- No plastic bags
- No soft plastics
- No polystyrene foam cups, meat trays or packing
- No waxed coffee cups
- No waxed cardboard
- No disposable nappies
- No broken glass or crockery
- No window glass

### PLACES TO RECYCLE OTHER ITEMS

Take your SOFT PLASTICS to Coles in Bairnsdale who are participating in the REDcycle program. Plastics  
need to be scrunch-able, empty and dry.

Take your PRINTER CARTRIDGES to Harvey Norman, Leading Edge, Office National or Australia Post stores in Bairnsdale.

Take your ELECTRONIC-WASTE to Bairnsdale Transfer station.

Take your household BATTERIES to all Aldi stores in Australia.
